- keeping in touch with natural caregivers of the elderly in order to encourage them to be familiar with our

- assuring that each client-beneficiary has a dossier, a personalized plan and that an appropriate follow
- up is planned

- coordinating, organizing two annual conferences, as well as monthly café-rencontres
- coordinating the info-mobile unit that will be held in public places such as pharmacies, doctors' offices,
